## 2011 Year End Statistical Report

### 2011 Highlights

- \* Number of Criminal Code incidents declined for the 3rd consecutive year.
- \* Violent crime down, but still a concern.
- \* Crime Reduction Strategy instrumental in 31% decrease in property damage cases.
- \* Robberies down 45% over the 5-year average.
- \* Traffic Accidents resulting in injuries decline for 5th consecutive year, but pedestrian accidents remain a concern.

### Introduction

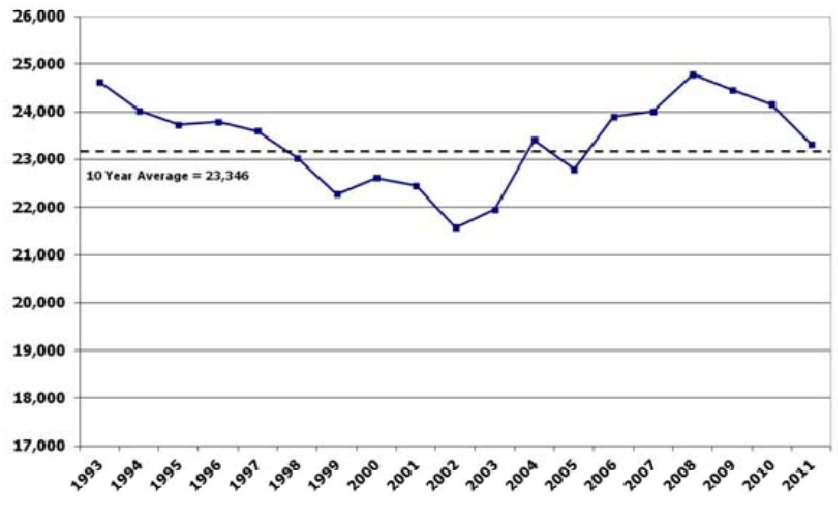
This report is a review of occurrences in the City of Fredericton for 2011. The data is compared to the previous year and the 5-year average.

### Calls for Service

Total **calls for service** declined for the third consecutive year (3%) when compared to the previous year. There were a total of 23,322 calls for service in 2011, plus a total of 4,065 requests for criminal record checks and taxi licences.



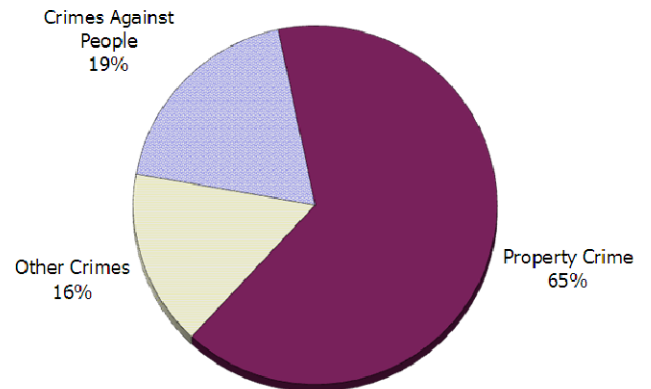
Calls for Service



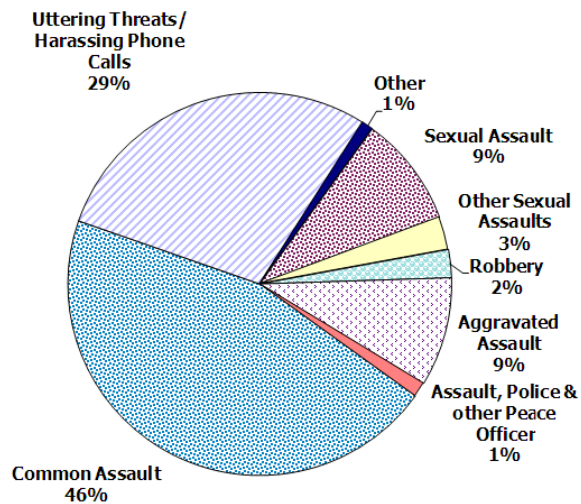
# Crime in the City of Fredericton

## Total 2011 Reported Crime

- ⇒ The majority of incidents reported in Fredericton are **property crime** (65%). This category includes crimes such as property damage, break & enter, and theft.
- ⇒ **Other crimes** include incidents such as breach of probation, failure to attend court, and indecent or harassing phone calls.



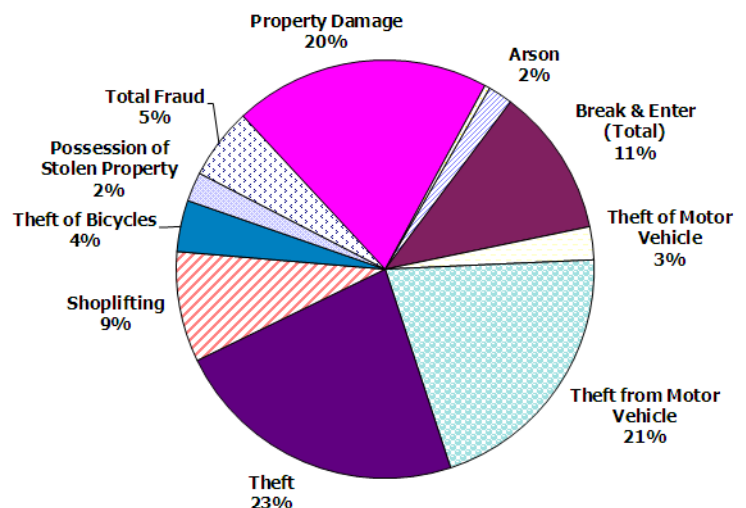
### Crimes Against People



- ⇒ The largest single category of crimes against people was **common assault**, representing just under half (46%) of the total violent crime.

- ⇒ The largest categories within property crime are **theft** (23%), **theft from motor vehicles** (21%), and **property damage** (20%).

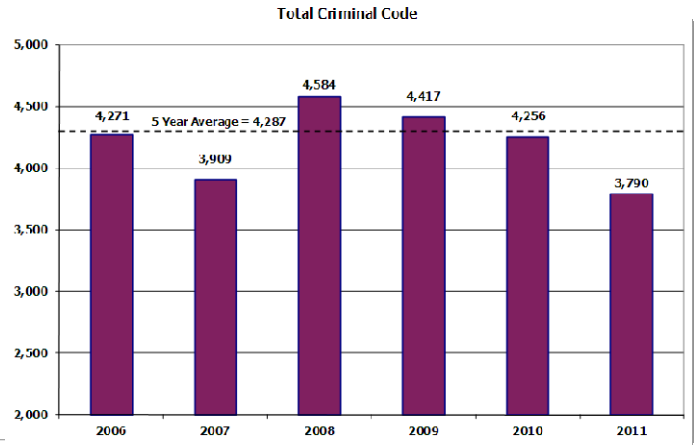

# Crime Comparison

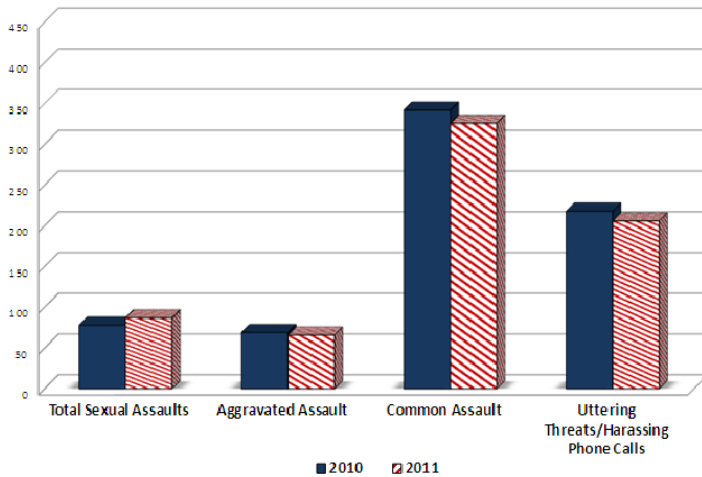
## 2011 vs. 2010 Data

- ⇒ **Total criminal code occurrences** have decreased 11% in 2011 when compared to 2010.
- ⇒ The decrease in property crime can be partially attributed to the implementation of the Crime Reduction Strategy.



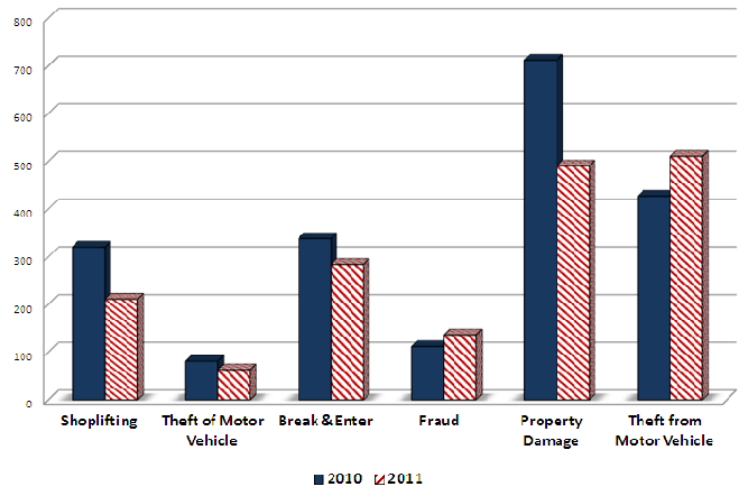
- ⇒ **Total crimes against people** decreased slightly by 4% in 2011 when compared to the previous year.
- ⇒ **Total sexual assaults** increased by 9 reported occurrences in 2011.
- ⇒ **Common assaults** decreased 5% in 2011 over 2010.

Selected Crime Categories



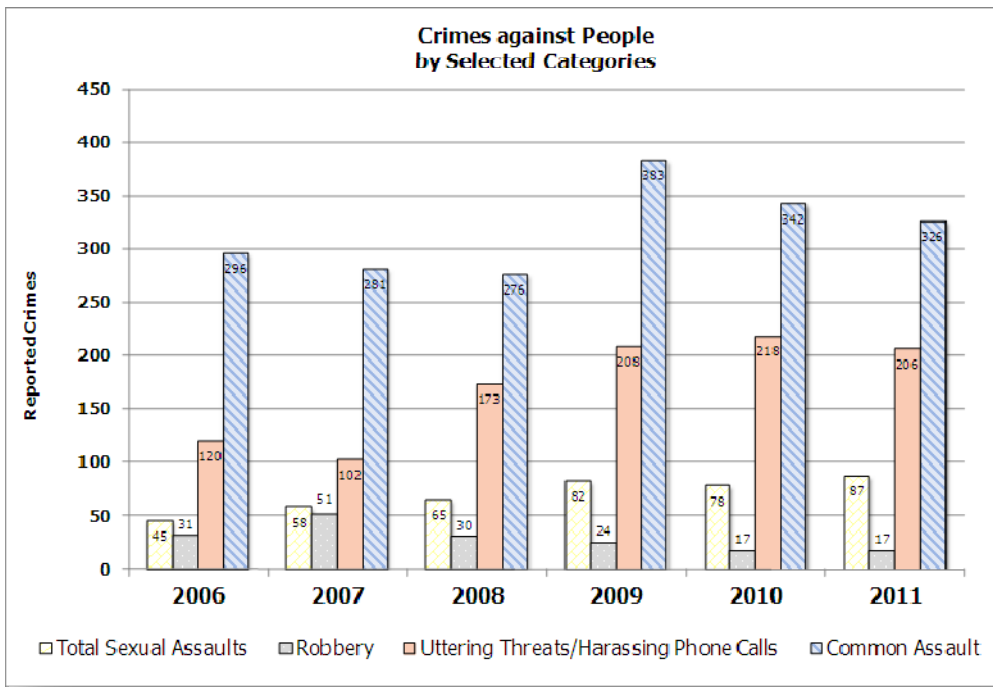
- ⇒ **Property crime** decreased 12% in 2011 when compared to the previous year.
- ⇒ There were notable decreases in reported incidents such as **property damage** (-31%), **shoplifting** (-34%), **theft of motor vehicle** (-22%), and **break & enters** (-16%).
- ⇒ There were increases in **theft from motor vehicles** (19%) and **fraud** (21%).

Selected Crime Categories



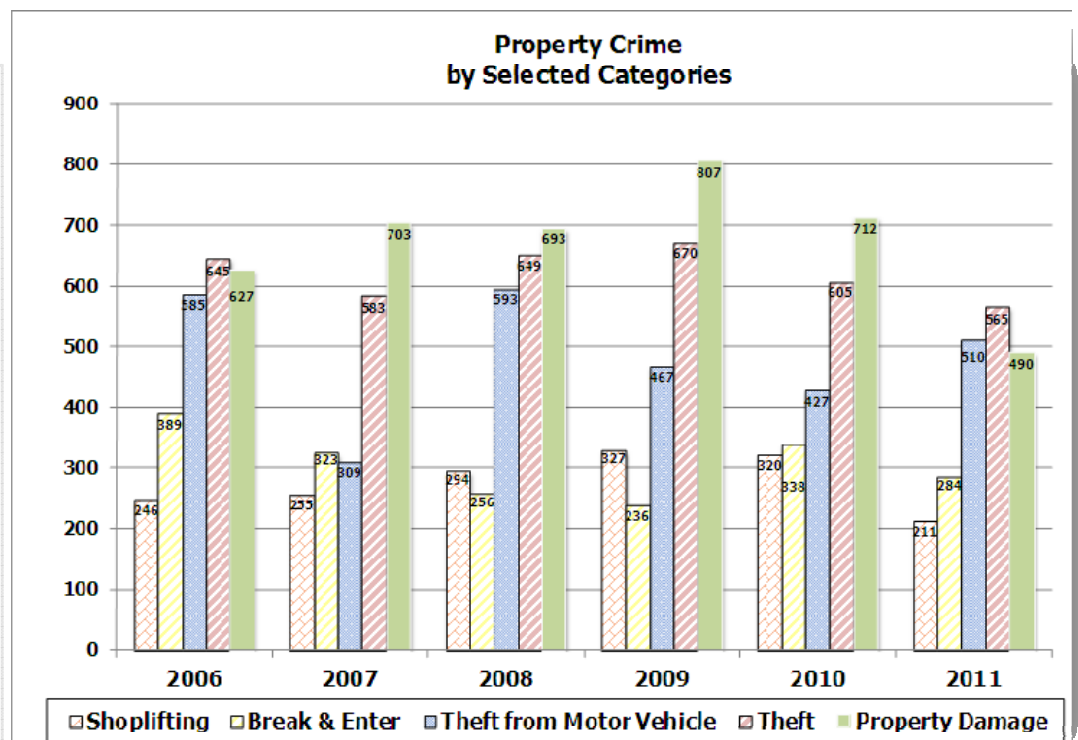
# Crime in the City of Fredericton

## 2011 vs. 5-Year Average



- ⇒ Total **crimes against people** increased by 8% in 2011 when compared to the 5-year average.
- ⇒ Total **sexual assaults** increased in 2011 when compared to the 5-year average and seem to be stabilizing when compared to the previous two years.
- ⇒ **Common assaults** increased slightly by 3%.
- ⇒ Reported **robberies** decreased 45% in 2011 when compared to the 5-year average.

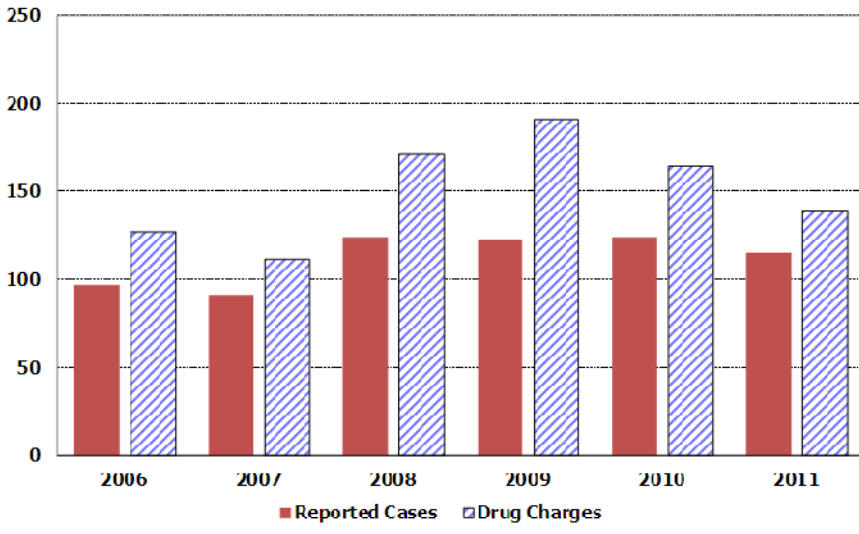
- ⇒ Total **property crime** decreased by 16% in 2011 when compared to the 5-year average.
- ⇒ Total **property damage** decreased significantly by 31% in 2011 when compared to the 5-year average.
- ⇒ **Break and enters** decrease (-8%) in 2011 when compared to the 5-year average.

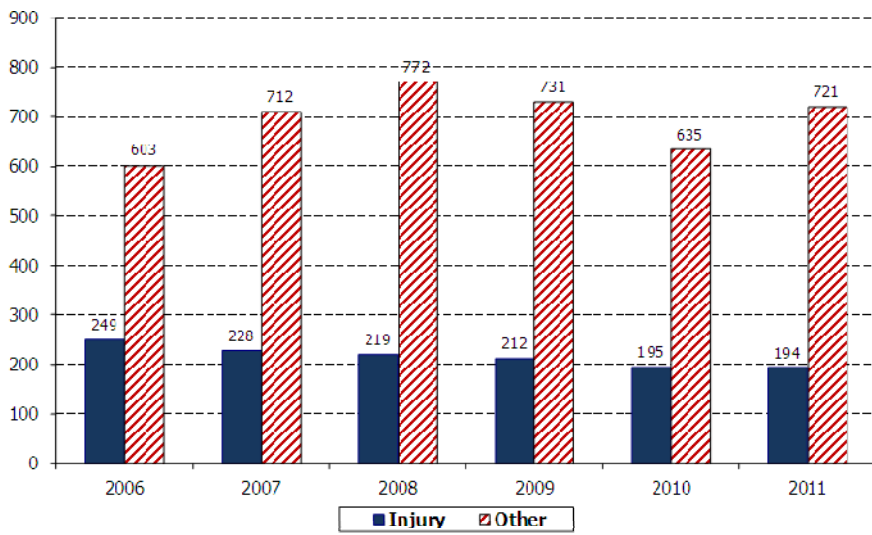
Drug and Substance Act  
Charges and Reported Cases



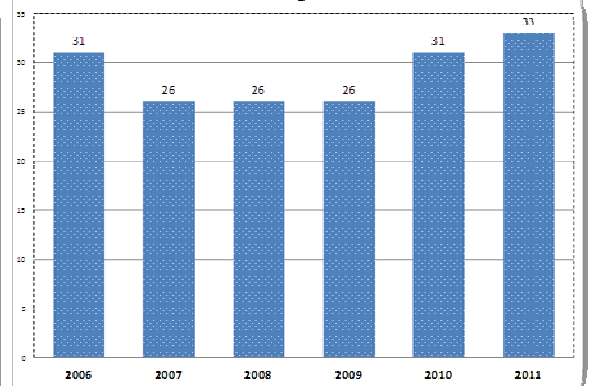
- ⇒ Total **drug** occurrences decreased slightly by 7% in 2011 when compared to 2010.
- ⇒ To date there have been 139 **charges** stemming from 115 drug occurrences. The number of charges will continue to increase as the files are processed through the court system in 2012.
- ⇒ In 2011, 76% of the drug crimes were the result of possession, trafficking, producing, or importing of **marijuana. Other illicit drugs and substances** accounted for 15% of the reported occurrences, while the remaining 9% involved **cocaine**.

⇒ **Total Motor Vehicle Accidents** in 2011 remained unchanged when compared to the 5-year average while accidents resulting in injury continued a 6 year decline. In 2011, there were two motor vehicle accidents resulting in fatalities. One fatality involved a pedestrian while the other involved a motorized vehicle.
