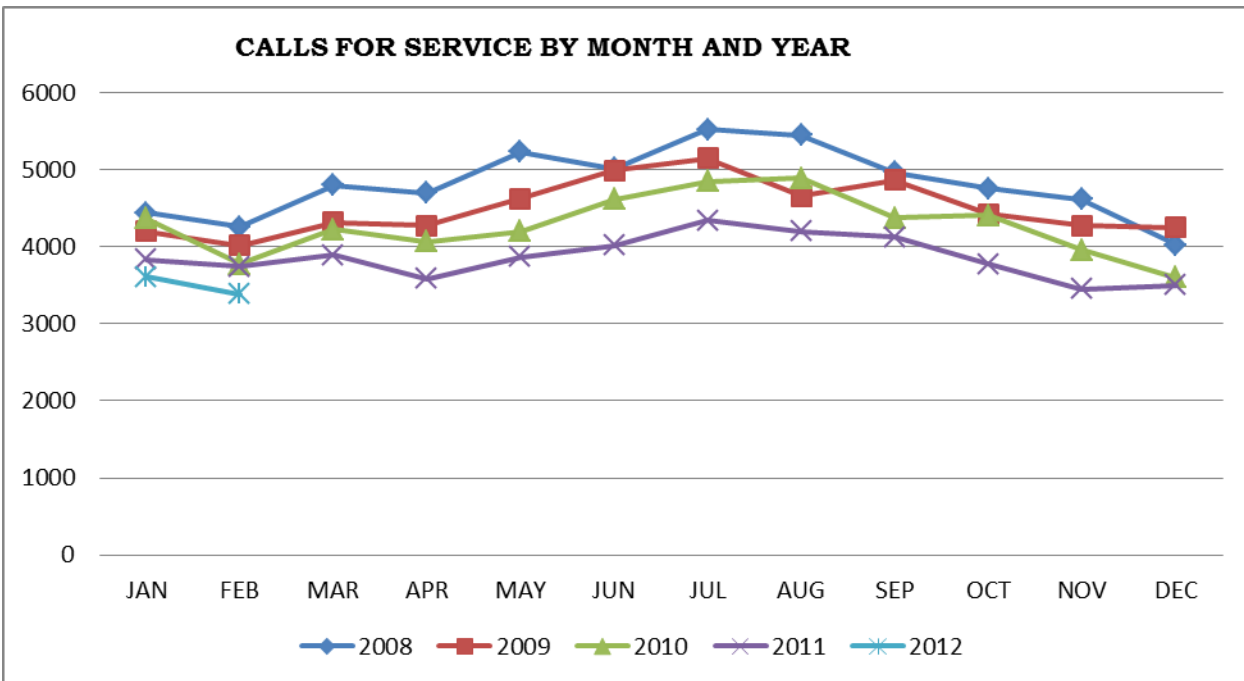
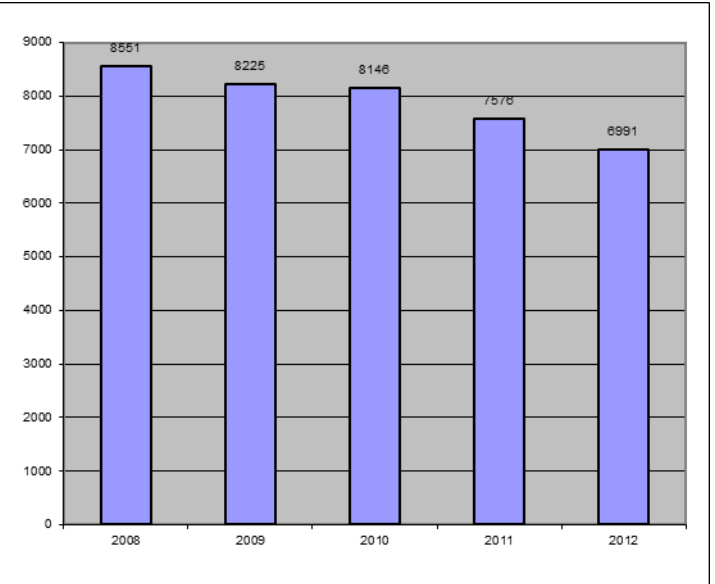
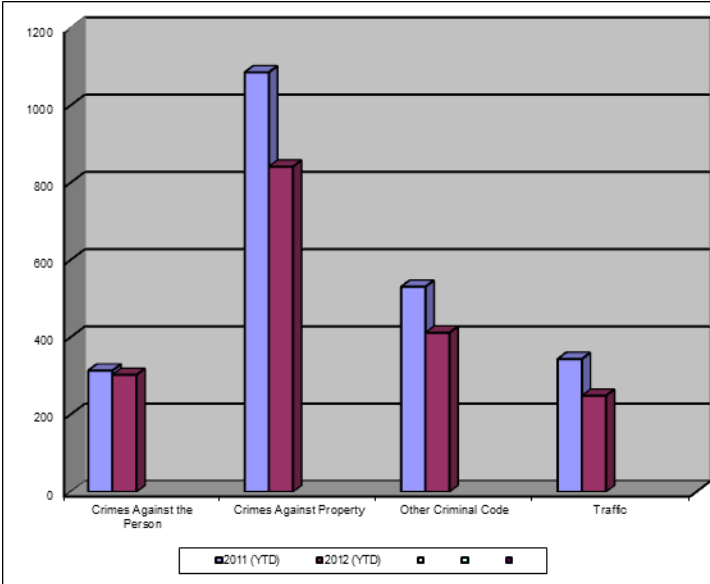

2. The crime statistics published in this report are accurate on the day that they were analyzed. Due to ongoing police investigation and internal data quality control efforts, this information is subject to change, including addition, deletion and reclassification of any and all data. Rates and percentages have been rounded.
3. Rate is calculated on a per 100,000 rate for each month and year. As provided by Capital Region District, the 2011 and 2012 population is estimated at 100,657.
